



How do I connect to the WSU SSID?

You must use a Web browser to authenticate and establish a connection. Afterward, you can use any network application, such as e-mail client software on your laptop.

1. You first need to be in a location where the WSU SSID is available.
See [Access point \(AP\) locations by building](#).
2. Insert your wireless card (unless the wireless card is built-in), and turn on your computer.
3. Launch a Web browser.
 - Your browser home page automatically opens the WSU Network authentication page.
 - If you are prompted about a certificate, click **Yes**.
4. Type your WSU AccessID (e.g. xy6789) in the User Name box and, in the Password box, type in the same password you use for WSU Pipeline or WSU E-mail.
5. Click the Log in button.
6. After a small logout pop-up window opens, minimize the logout window.
7. When you are ending your Internet session, make sure you close your connection. To do so, click the logout window.

Note: If you walk out of range, or your computer goes into sleep mode or is turned off for more than 3 minutes, WSU's wireless network will log you out.
